This document contains questions that could spoil the plot! For the best experience, read the book before browsing the questions.

1. How does Logan's initial impression of Ramsbolt represent the changes happening in her own life?
2. How does the setting of Ramsbolt, quite different from her New York world, push against the person she thinks she is and force her to face her misbeliefs about life? How does the town influence who she becomes?
3. How are the socioeconomic differences between Logan's New York life and her life in Ramsbolt represented in her character arc?
4. What misbeliefs about life does Logan face?
5. Which of Ramsbolt's residents do you like the most? Do any town residents rub you the wrong way?
6. When the book begins, it's easy not to feel sympathy for Logan as she approaches life from a position of privilege. What moment in the story shifted your feelings for Logan? If you never found sympathy for her, what would have made you root for her?
7. How did the plot challenge Logan's thinking and force her to face her misbeliefs about life?
8. Which characters find redemption through the book and in what ways? Is the door still open for town characters to find redemption in future books?
9. If you could have made life harder for Logan, what would you have done? What event could have made her life easier? How would those events have altered the course of her character arc?

10. What single event do you think changed Logan more than any other?
11. Which of Logan's decisions did you disagree with and why?
12. What are the dynamics of power between the characters and how do they shift over the course of the book?
